On 28 and 29 May 2027, we are planning a community event called *River Stories* in Goolwa looking at how we can care better for the Murray-Darling waterways and the people, plants and animals that live with and alongside it.

This is a trilogy of art installations and performance events, with the first one in St George, QLD (12 and 13 March 2027), the second one in Menindee, NSW (16 and 17 April 2027), and the third one in Goolwa, SA

(28 and 29 May 2027). These events flow in the direction of the rivers and connect stories across locations.
